

Our final stop is the Coffee Museum. Here you'll have a lesson in coffee etiquette, learning how guests are honoured in Arabic culture. In this silent ritual, every gesture – such as how the cup is held – has a deep meaning. You'll leave with a memento of your day: a pouch of real Arabic coffee, so you can try and recreate what you've learned once you're back at home.



Get closer to nature



Discover the story behind the stunning wildlife of Sir Bani Yas Island with a guided tour in a specially designed Land Cruiser.

The Arabian Wildlife Park is a beautiful nature reserve that occupies more than half of the island. It was established in 1977 by Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan when he passed a law preventing hunting on the island. His vision was to create a haven for animals – both local and foreign – to roam free and live naturally.

It's now home to thousands of animals, and your local expert guide will help you spot many different species as you explore – and give you plenty of photo stops along the way. Look out for gazelles, llamas, giraffes, ostriches and one of the world's largest herds of endangered Arabian oryx. There are cheetahs, hyenas, and more than 100 species of indigenous wild birds, while the waters around the island are home to sea turtles and dolphins.



All developmental work on the island has been carried out with a view to conserving its fragile ecosystem. You'll return to the ship having enjoyed time alongside some wonderful creatures you may otherwise never see in such a natural setting.

If you're in a larger group, you can tour the nature reserve together in a truck instead of a 4x4.

Dig into ancient history



Gain a unique insight into life on Sir Bani Yas island as it was hundreds of years ago, in this guided tour around the remains of an early-Christian monastery site.

The monastery dates back to the end of the 6th century, and is the only early Christian site in the UAE. Buried over time, it was rediscovered on the eastern side of the island in the early 1990s, and excavations have been taking place ever since.

During your guided walking tour, you'll learn more about the history of the area and the lifestyle of its inhabitants. You'll also be able to view artefacts unearthed by the archaeologists.


Following your tour, you'll re-board your coach for a visit to the Majlis, at the centre and highest point of the island. This was where many dignitaries were welcomed and entertained during Sheik Zayed's lifetime, and offers spectacular views. From there, we'll take a drive around the rest of this beautiful island before heading back to the pier.

First destination of the day will be the Sheikh Zayed Mosque – the largest in the UAE and a stunning example of neo-Islamic architecture. 1,000 pillars support 82 marble domes and four minarets in this sprawling complex that covers more than 30 acres. Capture the dramatic contrast between its startling white marble exterior and the bright blue Middle Eastern sky that is its backdrop.

Next we'll drive along the Corniche Road, which sweeps around the main Abu Dhabi island, with its distinctive skyline of futuristic glass skyscrapers. There'll be plenty of opportunities to take photos of these spectacular buildings, including the famous Emirates Palace Hotel with its 114 domes and 1.3km of private beach.


Then it's off to the dates market, passing the Manarat Al Saadiyat arts and cultural centre and its arresting honeycomb exterior on the way. 

Join us on a cultural tour of discovery through magnificent Abu Dhabi, with a closer look at two of the city's most iconic landmarks.

After a quick photo stop to capture the grandeur of Abu Dhabi's iconic skyline, we'll head to our first destination: Qasr Al Watan Palace. The presidential palace of the United Arab Emirates is not only spectacular to look at, it is a celebration of the UAE's heritage.

Made of granite and limestone, this mainly white palace is very intricately designed. Walk through the Great Hall and the extensive gardens and you cannot help but be impressed by its opulence and splendour. A 37 metre dome tops the central chamber and a magnificent chandelier includes no fewer than 350,000 pieces of crystal.

From the seat of state power to the realm of the spiritual; our second stop is the stunning Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque. Rising out of beautifully manicured gardens and tranquil pools, the mosque's architecture is a carefully considered combination of Middle Eastern styles. Covering more than 30 acres, it is the country's largest mosque and boasts 1,000 pillars supporting 82 marble domes and four minarets.

Keep your cameras close at hand as you enjoy a glimpse into the rich tapestry of Abu Dhabi's cultural legacy.





Next, it's on to the Bahrain National Museum, the country's most popular tourist destination. With exhibits depicting life in Bahrain through the ages – including a reassembled ancient burial ground dating back to 2,800 BC – the museum's nine halls are a treasure trove of information and insight into the region.

Our next stop will be Manama's bazaar, located in the heart of Bahrain's capital. Split into new and old sections, you'll find everything from clothes and antiques to spices and traditional medicines in stalls spread across the souq's labyrinthine lanes and alleyways. Just make sure you've left space in your luggage!

From bazaar to Bahrain Fort, one of the country's most important historical sites. The fort itself was built by the Portuguese in the 16th century, but excavations of the site have revealed evidence of six other eras, including that of the Dilmun civilization in around 3,000 BC.

You'll conclude your Bahrain adventure at the 4-star Novotel Al Dana boutique hotel and resort for some well-deserved relaxation and a bite to eat. Enjoy a non-alcoholic welcome drink on arrival, followed by a delicious array of traditional Arabic mezze, kebabs and dishes from the grill. All washed down with a glass of wine. The Al Jasra Handicraft Centre is our penultimate stop, located in the village of the same name. As you move through the Centre's rooms, you'll see examples of some of the country's traditional crafts, including palm weaving, pottery and woodwork.

Before we head back to the ship we'll make a final stop at the impressive King Fahd causeway – 25 kilometres of bridges and causeways completed in 1986 and connecting Bahrain and Saudi Arabia for the first time in 25,000 years.

Next stop, a photo stop by the Bahrain National Museum. Built in 1988, this \$34 million postmodern complex overlooking the waterfront offers visitors a fascinating view of Bahrain through the ages, thanks to artefacts dating back to the ancient Dilmun civilisation.

Manama Souq awaits for some free time to explore, meandering the alleyways and shopping for souvenirs, before heading to a visit of the Bahrain Fort. Site of an ancient tell (a mound created by centuries of rebuilding) and a former Portuguese military fortification, this is one of Bahrain's most important historical locations and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

At 240 metres high, the World Trade Centre's twin sail-shaped, 50-storey towers are connected by wind turbines. Pearling was central to trade in Bahrain for thousands of years and in this half-day tour you'll discover the rich history of what's known as the pearling pathway - 3.5km of walkway connecting three oyster beds, the Bu Maher Fort and 17 buildings in the historical section of Muharraq.

Before travelling to the UNESCO World Heritage Site that is the pearling pathway, you'll be collected from the port and taken to the Bahrain National Museum, where a section dedicated to the pearl diving tradition can be found in the Hall of Traditional Trades and Crafts.

This part of the pearling pathway is a tribute to famous jeweller Jacques Cartier, who travelled to Bahrain in the 1920s to source its pearls with their unequalled lustre and roundness; the result of freshwater springs in the saltwater sea surrounding Bahrain.

Depart from port for a panoramic drive to The Bahrain National Museum. On your way, you will see bridges, aquamarine blue water, Gulf Hotel, Grand Mosque etc.

Bahrain National Museum built in 1988, the \$34 million complex offers a comprehensive view of Bahrain through the ages. Arguably the most interesting of the exhibits in nine halls is a reconstructed ancient burial mound dating to around 2800 scathe mound was actually plucked from the desert and reassembled in the museum. This museum is a virtual treasure house of history. One of the halls is devoted to Pearl and Pearling lifestyle can see how divers use to go down in ancient times.

Since ancient times, Bahrain has been famous for pearl diving and for the finest natural pearls in the Gulf area and in the world. Divers would be let down on a weighted rope, remain submerged for about one minute, collecting an average of eight to twelve oysters, and would then be drawn up by the puller (a well-muscled man who would remain on deck). Pearl diving reached its climax during the 19th century, before its fall in the early 20th century following

the discovery of oil and the introduction of the cultured pearl from Japan. It has been documented that 35000 tons of oysters were harvested annually during the 19th century which produced 80-90 % of the natural pearls in the world.

However, the tradition lives on, and about once a year the dhows will set sail to the pearling banks in search of the 'jewels of the deep'.

Bahraini natural pearls are considered the finest in the world, and incredibly - if you find a pearl whilst diving, it's yours to keep; an excellent (and possibly valuable!) souvenir. At the end return back to port.




